

PROPOSITION 4

What it is, what it is NOT, and why it matters!

Proposition 4 (Prop 4): “The constitutional amendment to dedicate a portion of the revenue derived from state sales and use taxes to the Texas Water Fund and to provide for the allocation and use of that revenue.”

EARLY VOTING: MONDAY, OCTOBER 20 - FRIDAY, OCTOBER 31

ELECTION DAY: TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4

PROP 4: WHAT IT IS

Prop 4 will dedicate \$1 billion per year of state sales tax revenue to water supply and infrastructure projects for each of the next 20 years, providing more reliable water systems for communities across Texas.



PROP 4: WHAT IT IS NOT

Prop 4 is NOT new taxes or fees. Prop 4 will fund \$1 billion of water projects per year for the next 20 years without any tax increase because the revenue will come from the existing state sales tax.

PROP 4: WHY IT MATTERS

Our economy, communities, and future depend on water. Texas' population is projected to grow 70% in the next 50 years, but our water supply won't be enough to support that growth, creating over \$200 billion in infrastructure needs. Prop 4 would:

- Increase our state's water supply to ensure all communities have enough water, especially during drought.
- Help fund needed repairs and replacement of aging and leaking water pipes.
- Ensure communities have clean water to drink by improving the safety and reliability of our water systems.
